## GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS:

The following points must be noted by students for the upcoming session:

- 1. Students registering themselves after commecement of classses, shall be liable to deposit the fine.
- 2. All Sessional test will be of 3 hrs duration (ST-1 from Unit 1 & 2 and ST-2 from Unit 1 to 4 and PUT from the whole syllabus).
